MODULE #8 An Introduction to Rheumatology

In 2005, she moved to Brisbane working within the rheumatology department at the Princess Alexandra Hospital and co-ordinated several research programmes at the Queensland University of Technology. She has over 40 publications. In 2019, she commenced as a Nurse Practitioner (Rheumatology) at the Gold Coast University Hospital.

She completed MSc Advanced Health Care Practice in 2006, Nurse Practitioner Masters in 2012, became endorsed as the first Australian Rheumatology NP in May 2013 and is the current chair of the Rheumatology Health Professionals Special Interest Group of the ARA.
